Attendance Policy for Classes and Rehearsals

- Dancers must fully commit to the training and rehearsals that prepare us for the final performance! Missing more than the allotted number of rehearsals and/or classes throughout the performance season (September 1 December 13) may result in the inability to perform without any refund. Even if a dancer falls within the allowed number of absences, they may be required to schedule make-up private lessons (at the dancer's expense: \$35 per 30 min. lesson) to catch up on missed material.
- Allowed up to four (4) absences*: Pre Ballet, Elementary 1
- Allowed up to three (3) absences*: Elementary 2, Ballet 1-2, Contemporary 2/3
- Allowed up to two (2) absences*: Ballet 3-5, Contemporary 4/5

General Costume Care

- All costumes are RENTALS and dancers will leave their costume(s) at the theater.
- Add your first and last name NOT INITIALS to all personal belongings: shoes, tights, dance bags, etc.
- Make a checklist of items you need to bring to the theater: make-up, undergarments, shoes, tights, water, etc.
- Be organized so you do not lose costume accessories while you have quick changes in the crowded dressing room. Take the extra 10 seconds to put things away properly to avoid losing them and then not be able to perform.
- Do not leave personal items overnight at the theater.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO EATING IN COSTUME!** Thank you for reminding those around you to not eat in or around costumes. When eating is necessary: Take your costume off. Eat non-messy foods. ONLY eat in designated areas. Having snacks and plenty of fluids is important to have enough energy and power to perform throughout the weekend. Encourage your dancers to eat regularly! And away from all costumes.

Makeup, Hair & Costume Notes All tutorials on the "Students Only" page (password: iloveaapa)

Littles Stage Makeup: Rosy blush (not too light), red lipstick, mascara (optional for ages 3-5), earth tones and brown shades of eye shadow.

- Pre-Ballet (Angels), Elementary 1 (Mice) Girl's hair in high ballet bun. Pink ballet shoes and tights. Boys' hair neatly brushed or tied back. Boys in white ballet shoes. <u>Tutorial for stage makeup -Angels & Mice</u> <u>Tutorial for hair - Angels & Mice</u>
- Elementary 2 (Party Kids) Hair in two French braids. Black ballet shoes (provided) and pink tights. <u>Tutorial for stage makeup -Party Kids</u>
 <u>Tutorial for french braids Party little kids</u>

Tweens Stage Makeup: Foundation, rosy blush (not too light), red lipstick, earth tones and brown shades of eye shadow, black eyeliner, and mascara. <u>Tutorial for Polichinelles Makeup</u>

- **Ballet 1A/B (Polichinelles)** Girl's hair in low ballet bun with right side part. Black ballet shoes (provided), pink tights and nude leotard undergarment. Boy's hair gelled or tied back with right side part. Black ballet shoes. <u>Tutorial for Polichnelles hair</u>
- Ballet 2 (Party Kids), Contemporary 2/3 (Toy Soldiers) Hair in mid ballet bun. Black ballet shoes (provided). Nude leotard undergarment.

Teen/adult Stage Makeup: Foundation, 2 shades of blush (bright-top and shadow-below), red lipstick, red lip liner, earth tones and brown shades of eye shadow, black or dark brown eyeliner and mascara, black false eyelashes (eye lash glue). <u>Tutorial for full stage makeup</u>.

• **Ballet 3 (Russian)**- Hair in mid ballet bun. Character shoes (provided) and pink tights. Nude leotard undergarment.

- **Corps de Ballet** Hair in mid ballet bun. Pink ballet shoes or pink pointe shoes (remember to have a back-up pair of pointe shoes), and pink tights. Nude leotard undergarment.
- Contemporary 4/5 (Rats) Hair in mid ballet bun. Grey ballet shoes (provided). Nude leotard undergarment.

Tights

All performers will receive 1 pair of performance tights at Dress Rehearsal to ensure every dancer has the same color/style. We strongly suggest every dancer buys at least one EXTRA pair of performance tights in case their performance pair gets torn, stained, or lost. The dancewear boutique will have the correct color and style of tights for each class available for purchase, so everyone looks the same under lights onstage. Please purchase early so we do not run out of inventory.

Shoes

Shoes must be clean and new looking. If shoes are worn out (visible holes, frayed material) find a new pair for the performances. If your shoes are dirty, clean with a light dish soap to remove dirt, or find a new pair. Do not put canvas shoes in the dryer. If you need to find or purchase a new pair of shoes, do this early to allow for shipping and inventory stock.

- DO NOT WEAR YOUR DANCE SHOES OUTSIDE EVER.
- Put your full name on the INSIDE of shoes.
- Tuck ties in shoes.
- Sew ballet elastic as directed. No tied ribbons or elastics around your ankles.

Final Costume Notes:

- Pre-teens (ages 9+), teens, and adults please wear deodorant.
- Undergarments (nude leotards) are needed to be worn under all borrowed costumes. (mice and angels exempt)
- Remember: No glitter, no earrings, no jewelry, no hair ties on wrists, no additional hair accessories, no nail polish (clear only), no fake tattoos.

Dress Rehearsal

- At Castle Theater on Saturday, December 14. MANDATORY FOR ALL DANCERS. If you miss your stage time, you will not perform. Thank you for understanding the preparation, spacing and practice needed before being on stage.
- All dancers will arrive with their hair and make-up complete and are responsible for warming up properly.
- All dancers will be dropped off & pick up at the backstage area of Castle Theater. When you arrive at the Lobby, take a left and follow the theater building to the back. Parking back there is reserved for staff only. Check your dancer in, and then wait outside.
- Parents and siblings are not allowed to enter the dressing rooms. We will have class moms assisting younger children.
- Parents and siblings are not allowed to view dress rehearsal.
- Dancers may leave when they are dismissed.

Theater and Performance Etiquette-Dancers and Parents

- Dancers may not watch in the theater before or after they perform on show day.
- Dancers should not be dressed in costume when entering the front of the house and should not enter lobby or auditorium seating.
- Do not go outside in your costume.
- Do not leave the theater/backstage during rehearsals or performances.
- You are expected to keep your area clean.
- Never touch curtains, props, or costumes that are not yours. Parents, please discuss these rules with your dancer.
- No photography or any videos allowed during performances. Photography flashes and lit cell phone screens are VERY distracting to dancers causing potential injury, and is also considered inconsiderate. Silence your cell phones.
